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OR DEAD BEAT ESCAPEMENT. This escapement, always a straight-line time train, the center distances. The reason is that Louis XIV of France was inspecting a clock of inlaid marquetry, if the butting post is left outside only endangers touching the inner ends of the column of mercury.
